1. Application

Submit an online application via the XAA Application Portal and upload all required documents according to the checklist.

2. Pay the Application Fee

To initiate the application process, you are required to pay the Application Fee of \$888* (upfront, non-refundable). Please send a screenshot of the payment to the Admissions Team when the fee is paid.

3. Application Review

The Admissions Department will review all completed applications. Some applicants may be invited to sit for an English Language proficiency test, assessment, or a meeting with the Academic Team. Our Admissions team will guide you through every step of the process.

4. Offer

Successful applicants will receive an official Offer Letter from the school's Admissions Department. As part of the application process, you will be required to pay an upfront, non-refundable Enrollment Fee of \$2,480* upon receiving the offer letter. After that, you will receive a Student Contract for your acceptance and an invoice for the tuition fees.

5. Enrollment

Once all documentation is submitted, and tuition fees are paid, your family will be all set to embark on an exhilarating learning journey at XAA. In addition, the school will send you a Welcome Information Pack before the first day of school.

What is Included in the Tuition Fees?

- · Academic progress testing
- Essential academic resources, textbooks, learning materials, and resources
- For all school-related activities and excursions, with the exception of any overnight trips, the school will provide bus transportation for our students.

What is Not Included in the Tuition Fees?

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

School Uniform

\$100- \$160 (excluding GST) for a complete uniform (standard uniform and PE attire).

Overnight/Overseas Learning Trips/Excursions

\$500 - \$3,150 (excluding GST) per year, depending on the activity/activities.

Extra-Curricular Activities (ECAs)

\$100 (excluding GST) per ECA per quarter (for activities conducted by the XAA staff).

\$200 - \$500 (excluding GST) per quarter for activities provided through external vendors. ECAs are not compulsory but highly encouraged.

Transportation Services

Subject to distance, paid directly to external bus vendor.

Lunch/Snacks

\$28 to \$50 per week, depending on the number of meals ordered. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch/snack to school.

Technology Fees

A Technology Fee has been introduced for students in Grades 5-8 and covers technology support and the installation of school-provided learning applications and software on students' devices. In cases where students do not have their own devices, the school will provide them with one. Please refer to the Miscellaneous Fees table for more information about the Technology Fee.

English as an Additional Language (EAL)

EAL Program is offered to students from Grade 1. For more information, please refer to the Miscellaneous Fees table.

Stationery

Costs vary, depending on the grade and subject. The school provides essential stationery resources used within the classroom; however, personal items that students take home daily (such as calculators, exercise books, markers, pens, pencils, etc.) should be acquired from external vendors.

External Examinations Fee (if required)

Based on the actual costs charged to the school by the external vendor.

Learning Support

While we strive to create a positive, nurturing, and inclusive learning environment for our students, currently, XAA has limited internal learning support resources available within the school.

To address this, the school has partnered with certified and experienced external agencies to offer additional learning support to our students. These services are accessible to students who require additional support in addition to the existing limited resources within the school. All applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Important Admissions Information

Sibling Discounts, Concessions, and Scholarships

At this point, we do not offer sibling discounts, concessions, or scholarships. This policy will be reviewed annually.

English as an Additional Language (EAL) Program

XAA's English language proficiency requirements vary depending on a student's grade level. The EAL Program will become mandatory for students in Grades 1 – 8 if the school determines that the student requires this support program after conducting the English proficiency assessment. Our EAL Program supports students with limited English language proficiency skills. It develops written and spoken English capabilities to help them make the most of their time here at XAA.

Children entering **Nursery through to KG2** are not formally assessed prior to enrollment. The students will join the English-speaking environment and have language opportunities integrated into all classroom activities.

Students entering **Grade 1 and above** whose first language is not English or who are coming from a school where the language of instruction is not English may be required to sit for an English language proficiency assessment (WIDA). This will allow the school to determine whether the candidate can access the English-based curriculum and if they require additional English language support.

WIDA is a large-scale English language proficiency assessment designed by the World-Class Instructional Design and Assessment Consortium (WIDA) to assess students' English proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and oral language.

Students who require additional English language support to access the curriculum successfully will be placed in the EAL Program. Participation in this programme is mandatory.

Immunizations

Immunizations are one of the prerequisites for application and subsequent enrollment at XAA. All applicants are required to submit a copy of vaccination records via the online application form as part of the admissions process.

Foreign-born children aged 12 and below

All foreign-born children aged 12 and below are also required to provide documentary proof of vaccination or evidence of immunity for diphtheria and measles to the Health Promotion Board (HPB) for verification before they can proceed with their applications to the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) or Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) for their long-term stay in Singapore. This requirement applies only to first-time applicants. Immunization against measles and diphtheria is mandatory in Singapore under the Fourth Schedule of the Infectious Diseases Act (Cap 137). For more information, please refer to the HPB website.

Disclosure of Nationality

Parents are required to fully disclose the nationality/citizenship status of all applicants—including dual nationality. Specifically, any applicant who holds Singapore citizenship, either by birth or registration, must declare this information at the time of the application, as approval from the Ministry of Education (MOE) is required before the course commencement. Enrolled families must immediately notify the Registrar Department of any change in their nationality and residency status.

MOE Exemption

The school will provide personalized assistance for your application for exemption status to the MOE, and we will guide you through this process.

Application for an exemption from the MOE

XAA will liaise directly with the MOE on the application's progress and update the family accordingly once an outcome has been reached. The MOE will take approximately up to eight weeks to review the application and inform XAA thereafter.

You are encouraged to provide all the relevant documents in your application, as incomplete applications will delay the processing time. A completed application and the full set of required documents will be passed to the Admissions Committee for review. Once an application has been reviewed, parents will be advised of their child's eligibility to be considered for admission. The school will contact successful applicants.

The Admissions Department will send you a formal Offer Letter and instructions on how to complete the enrollment process.

If your child requires an exemption from the MOE, please contact our Admissions Team ahead of the admission date, and we will guide you through the application process.

Student Pass

XAA intends to apply for EduTrust Certification to enroll students on Student Passes. At this point, the school does not facilitate Student Pass applications.

No Student Pass is required for students holding a Dependant's Pass, Immigration Exemption Order (IEO), or Singapore Permanent Residency (PR).



Grade Placement

As an international school in Singapore, XAA aims to ensure appropriate grade placement for every student based on their age and academic, social, and emotional development. For this reason, new students may be required to complete an appropriate grade-level screener to determine placement. Students applying to the school must be of an appropriate grade age by 1st September for admission consideration. Families are encouraged to refer to the below Grade Placement Guide to ensure that they are applying to the correct grade level, taking into account the differences in the naming of 'grades' around the world.
